

Third-party and self-rescue using the PARAT® 5550

1. Attachment and wearing options together with the Dräger PSS® 5000



D-44274-2015

Attachment on the waist belt
The holster can be attached with the integrated belt loop either on the right or the left side of the waist belt.



D-44308-2015

Wearing with the shoulder strap
The holster can be worn together with the approved shoulder strap.



D-49013-2015

Attachment to the backplate
The holster can be attached to the right or left side of the backplate with an approved carabiner hook.



D-44302-2015

Attaching to the cylinder strap
The holster can be attached to the cylinder strap using the integrated belt loop.

2. Removing the fire escape hood from the flame-retardant holster



D-44320-2015

Open the holster by pulling down on the yellow flap.



D-44346-2015

Take the fire escape hood completely out of the holster and open the foil pouch on the perforation.



D-44357-2015

Hold the foil pouch on the bottom end firmly together with the red tear-away straps and at the same time pull the fire escape hood out until the filter plugs are completely removed from the filter.



D-44362-2015

Both filter openings must be unobstructed in order to breathe freely.

3. Donning of the fire escape hood for third-party rescue



D-44425-2015

Widen the neck seal.



D-44382-2015

Place the opening of the fire escape hood on the chin of the person to be rescued.



D-44395-2015

Pull the fire escape hood over the head of the person to be rescued. The head harness automatically adjusts to fit.



D-44415-2015

Check the fit of the half mask by closing the front filter opening with the palm of your hand. If negative pressure is not generated, readjust the half mask to ensure a close fit.

4. Donning of the fire escape hood for self-rescue



D-44429-2015

Widen the neck seal and pull the fire escape hood over your head. The head harness automatically adjusts to fit.



D-44443-2015

Check the fit of the half mask by closing the front filter opening with the palm of your hand. If negative pressure is not generated, readjust the half mask to ensure a close fit.

Note: The Dräger PARAT® fire escape hoods are intended for single use only. The holster can be re-used.
